PARISH COUNCILLOR VACANCY

There is currently a vacancy on Ripplingale Parish Council and having been through the prescribed procedure, no election has been requested.

The vacancy will now be filled by the co-option process at the Meeting of the Parish Council on 7 June 2018.

Should anyone wish to be considered for this vacancy, they should apply in writing to the Clerk the address or email below, by no later than 27 May 2018.

Section 79(1) of the Local Government Act 1972 provides that, unless disqualified, a person is qualified to be co-opted as a local councillor if they are over 18, a qualifying Commonwealth citizen or a Euro national on the day of their selection and:


- a. Be registered as a Local Government Elector for the Parish on the current Electoral Register; or
- b. Have during the whole of the previous 12 months occupied as tenant or owner any land or other premises in the Parish; or
- c. Have had his/her principal or only place of work in the previous 12 months in the Parish of Ripplingale; or
- d. Have resided either in the Parish or within 3 miles thereof during the previous 12 months.

Should more than one application be received for the vacancy, councillors will decide the appointment by a vote, or series of votes, to obtain a majority decision.
